Cohortem primam *Frisiavonum*, cuius tribunum notitia (p. 114* 1, nam ita scribendum esse pro *Frixagorum*, quod traditur, Böckingius p. 905* alique perspexerunt) *Vindobalae* collocat (*Vindovala Ravennas* 5, 31 p. 432, 14), reperimus supra *Mancunii* fuisse in castris (cap. XX n. 213. 214); in *Rutchester* praefectorum tantum aliquot tituli reperti sunt cohorte alave, cui praefuissent, non nominata (n. 541. 542). Tamen situs dubitari non sinit, quin ibi fuerit proxima a Conderco statio valli versus occidentem, versus orientem ab Hunno, cuius situs titulis ibi repertis con-

firmitur. De castris *Vindobalae* cf. *Maclauchlan memoir* p. 17 et Bruce *wall* p. 125 sqq. Praeter sacrarii *Mithriaci* titulos (n. 541—544) prodierunt ibi lapides legionum tantum secundae (n. 545) et sextae (n. 544. 546), quos primus edidit J. FAIRLESS (sextae legionis etiam tegula extat ibidem eruderata), deinde cohortium centuriarumque soliti (n. 547—555) unusque sepulcralis.
