

1020 Half of an altar, in 1826 . . . used as a post to the wicket of the garden of the farm-house immediately east of the Hall Yards, . . . its upper part is so much worn with sharpening metallic implements upon it, or eaten with the weather, as to make it of no further use than in showing that the whole inscription had consisted of 14 lines HODGS. Iac. Forster dedit Hodgsoni, is museo in Newcastle, ubi servatur. Ara alta est ped. 4.







1024 Risingham; upon a broken stone lying for a seat at the fore door at the dwelling house, that is within the station HORSL. Videtur perisse.






1027 Centurial stone from Cramlington LAWSON. Servatur in Newcastle in museo.


