372 *Maryport*, m. Martio a. 1870 repertae sunt arae XVII, at the distance of about 350 yards from the Roman camp, in a circular plot of ground less than 50 feet in diameter; small pits had evidently been prepared for their reception. Usually two altars were found in one pit, sometimes one, sometimes three. Many pits were found which had apparently before been rifled of their contents. The altars have been deposited in haste and yet with care. A few of them are damaged, but they do not bear marks of wanton violence. In most of them the letters are sharp and clear, none of them are affected by the weather *BRUCE*.
