

Cohortem primam Frisiavonum, cuius tribunum notitia (p. 114\* 1, nam ita scribendum esse pro Frixagorum, quod traditur, Böckingius p. 905\* aliique perspexerunt) Vindobala collocat (Vindobala Ravennas 5, 31 p. 432, 14), reperimus supra Mancunii fuisse in castris (cap. XX n. 213. 214); in Rutchester praefectorum tantum aliquot tituli reperti sunt cohorte alave, cui praefuerint, non nominata (n. 541. 542). Tamen situs dubitari non sinit, quin ibi fuerit proxima a Conderco statio valli versus occidentem, versus orientem ab Hunno, cuius situs titulis ibi repertis con-

firmatur. De castris Vindobala cf. Maclauchlan *memoir* p. 17 et Bruce wall p. 125 sqq. Praeter sacrarii Mithriaci titulos (n. 541—544) prodierunt ibi lapides legionum tantum secundae (n. 545) et sextae (n. 544. 546), quos primus edidit J. FAIRLESS (sextae legionis etiam tegula extat ibidem eruderata), deinde cohortium centuriarumque soliti (n. 547—555) unusque sepulcralis. Inter miliarios posui titulum Caracallae a. 213, qui hoc pertinet.
