1057 Near Rochester HUNT. About half a mile north of Risingham, close by Watlingstreet and the high way (which is near to or upon it), lies an altar much of the same size and shape as post n. 1000; it has a praefericulum and a patera on one side and a garland on the other. There has no doubt been an inscription upon it, tho' now not the least sign of a letter appears. I think this cannot well be the same altar, which with the inscription upon it Dr. Hunter has described . . .; for the Doctor says he found that near Riechester. However, if this be not the same, I could neither see nor hear any thing of it HORSL.
